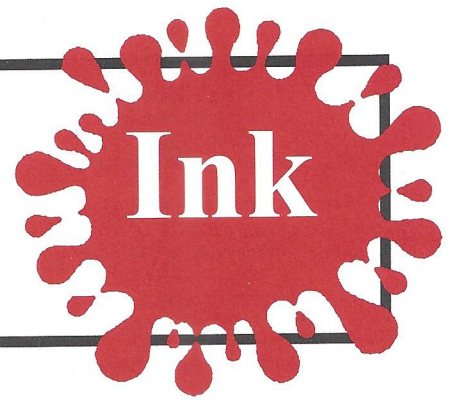

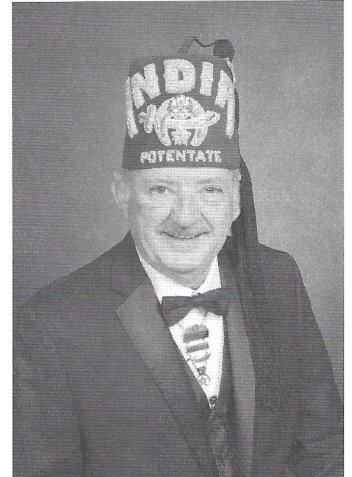
We have an update to our web site. Check out, "indiashriners.org" the India Ink is available to view along with points and other features. We are working hard to make improvements to the site.

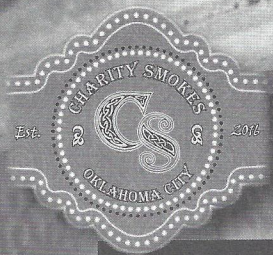
Welcome to the 2020 "Sweetheart" month. The INK says there will be a Valentines Dinner and Dance on Saturday, February 15.

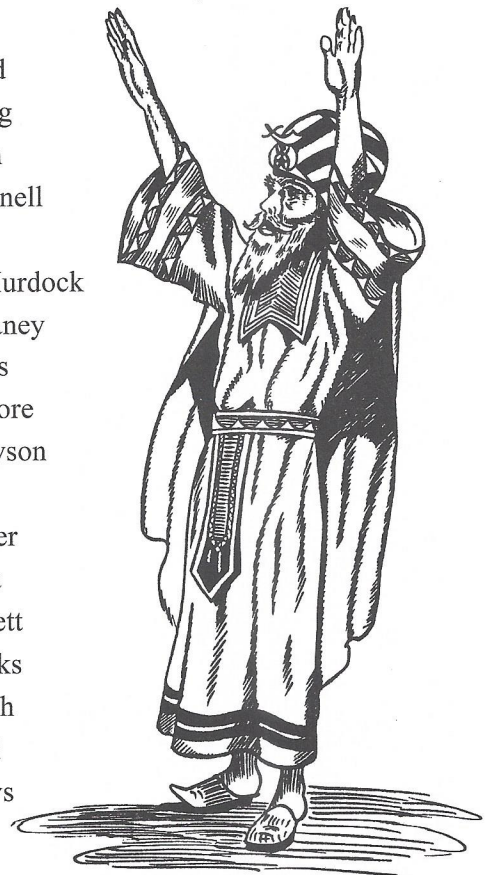
