A little history for you, involving brother Masons:

January 1st, 1776 – George Washington unveiled the Grand Union Flag, the first national flag in America. On January 3rd, 1777, Washington defeated the British at Princeton then set up winter headquarters at Morristown. On January 4, 1790, Washington delivered the first State of the Union address. On January 6th, 1941, President Franklin Roosevelt delivered his State of the Union address in which he defined four essential freedoms worth defending: freedom of speech, freedom of worship, freedom from want, and freedom from fear. On January 8th, 1815, General Andrew Jackson defeated the British at the Battle of New Orleans, unaware that the War of 1812 had been declared over two weeks earlier.

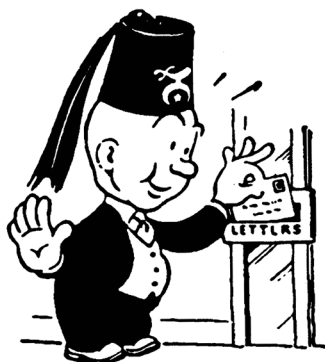
