

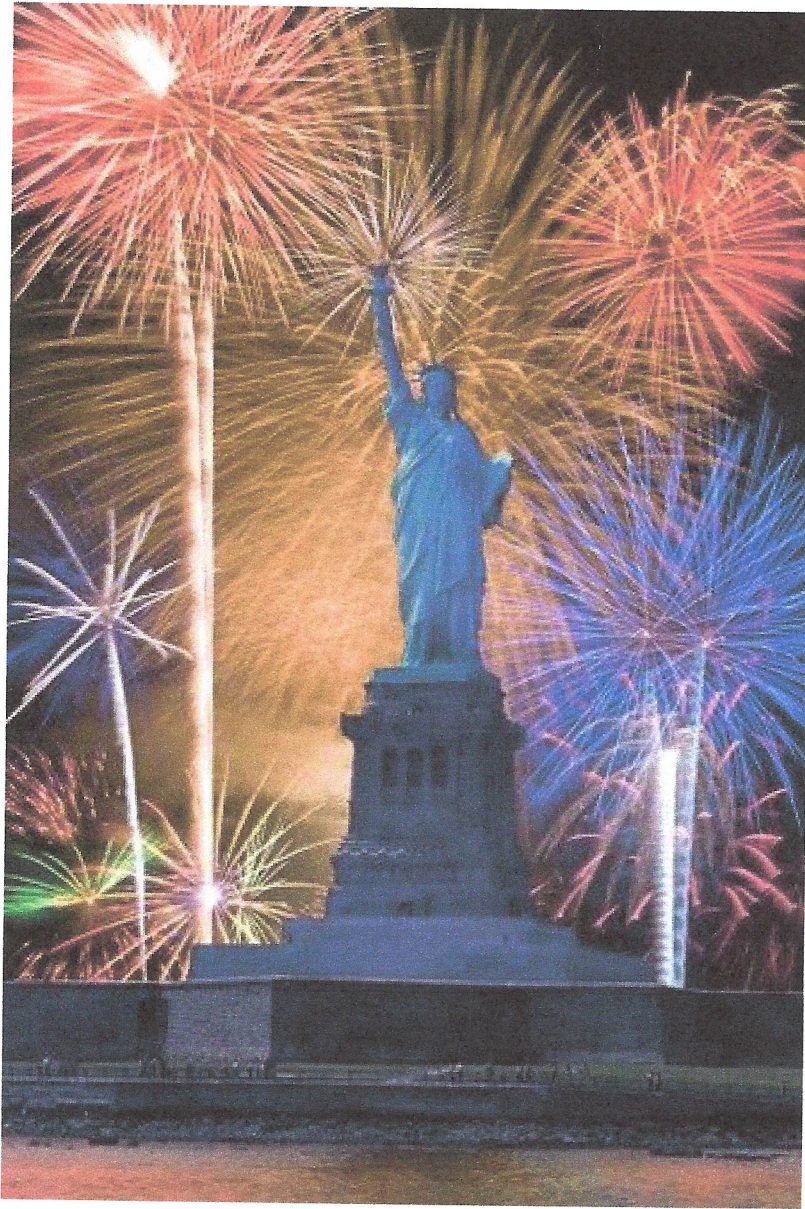

## Potentates Message

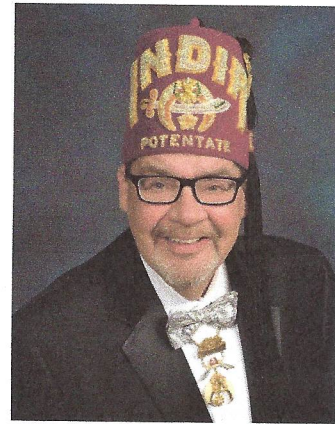

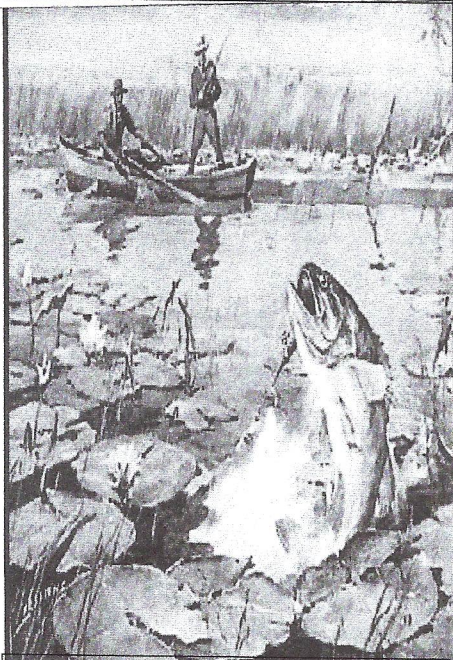

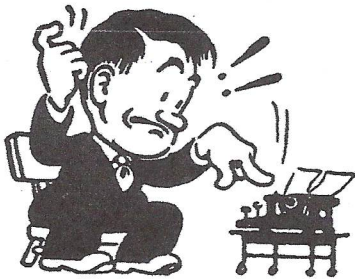
