Here are some interesting facts about World War II that you may have forgotten (or never knew). The Russian air force had an all-female bomber regiment between 1942 and 1945. Known as the "Night Witches", they carried out over 30,000 bombing missions against German forces. Japan attempted to attack the U.S. with bombs attached to balloons, starting in 1944. More than 9,000 were released, but fewer than 300 inflicted damage, all minimal. There was one battle where U.S. and German forces worked together. In May, 1945, the Waffen SS was sent to kill some high-profile French prisoners. The local German commander opposed the idea and, with the help of an American force, held off the SS until reinforcements arrived. Polish soldiers adopted a Syrian brown bear cub as their mascot, later using it to help carry crates of ammunition. The bear survived the war and lived until 1963 in the Edinburgh Zoo. The U.S. Navy almost torpedoed a ship carrying President Roosevelt. He was on board the U.S.S. Iowa when an escorting destroyer inadvertently fired a torpedo directly at the ship. The Iowa successfully executed a hard turn, narrowly avoiding the torpedo, which eventually exploded harmlessly in the water. Roosevelt, meanwhile, requested to have his wheelchair moved in the midst of the commotion for a better view of the action.
