



In order to be in compliance with Imperial Council By-Laws Sect. 325.11, the follow notice is hereby given:

325.11 Election Requirements

- (a) Electioneering. A candidate for an elected office in a Shrine temple may print, publish and circulate during the year he is seeking the elected office, a résumé consisting of his educational background, his vocational history, and his Masonic and Shrine record. Except as provided in the prior sentence, the printing, publication, circulating or distribution of resolutions, letters, telegrams, tickets, email or other devices, by a unit, club, Noble, or group of Nobles, suggesting, recommending, opposing, or containing the names of proposed candidates for office in the temple is prohibited.
- **(b) Expenditures Prohibited.** The expenditure of money for gifts, favors, or entertainment on behalf of a candidate for elected office is prohibited.
- (c) Violation. For any violation of (a) or (b), the Imperial Potentate may suspend any offending Noble, and he may declare the election of the officers void and order a new election.
- (d) Notice. At least one week prior to the annual meeting or any election, the Temple Recorder shall mail to each member a notice thereof containing this section



Here are more interesting facts about World War II that you may have forgotten (or never knew).. T-shirts are among the indispensable components of modern style, but they were once considered mere undergarments. The classic white garment first became a standard part of the U.S. Army's uniform during World War I. The undershirt was given a new name — the T-shirt — in the 1920s thanks to writer F. Scott Fitzgerald, and in World War II, it was once again made part of the standard-issue military uniform. By that time, T-shirts were already becoming more than just underwear; they were marketed to civilians and worn by younger crowds in high schools and universities. But it wasn't until after the war ended that they became ubiquitous. Soldiers returning home from combat had grown accustomed to the T-shirt's comfort and began incorporating the item into their everyday wear. Images of soldiers wearing T-shirts while serving their country also boosted the garment's popularity, and in the 1950s, movie stars such as Marlon Brando and James Dean made the T-shirt an undeniable staple of casual fashion. Blue jeans were already starting to seep into U.S. culture by the time soldiers reported for duty during the Second World War. Denim dungarees and coats had been worn by the U.S. Navy since the early 1900s, and by the 1930s, jeans were the de facto pants of Western movie stars — a symbol of the romanticized American cowboy. During World War II, however, blue jeans went global. U.S. soldiers stationed overseas were often from working-class Western families, and they wore their denim — some of which was made specifically for soldiers — with pride. By the early style was undeniable: The newly minted "teenager" demographic had adopted blue jeans as counterculture cool. Other developments on the home front also helped pave the way for the American denim boom. The rise of women in the workforce during the war, symbolized by Rosie the Riveter, positioned the workwear as practical, durable clothing that was both essential for industrial roles, and a staple of postwar women's fashion.

The dues paid by our associate members are used to provide the U.S. flag that flies just outside the parking lot entrance to the Shrine Center. 
