In order to be in compliance with Imperial Council By-Laws Sect. 325.11, the follow notice is hereby given:

# 325.11 Election Requirements

- (a) Electioneering. A candidate for an elected office in a Shrine temple may print, publish and circulate during the year he is seeking the elected office, a résumé consisting of his educational background, his vocational history, and his Masonic and Shrine record. Except as provided in the prior sentence, the printing, publication, circulating or distribution of resolutions, letters, telegrams, tickets, email or other devices, by a unit, club, Noble, or group of Nobles, suggesting, recommending, opposing, or containing the names of proposed candidates for office in the temple is prohibited.
- (b) Expenditures Prohibited. The expenditure of money for gifts, favors, or entertainment on behalf of a candidate for elected office is prohibited.
- (c) Violation. For any violation of (a) or (b), the Imperial Potentate may suspend any offending Noble, and he may declare the election of the officers void and order a new election.
- (d) Notice. At least one week prior to the annual meeting or any election, the Temple Recorder shall mail to each member a notice thereof containing this section


## Legion of Honor

We continue to plan for our annual banquet and officer installation on Saturday, January 11th, at the Shrine Center. This event will feature dinner provided by the unit for our regular and associate members and their ladies. Formal invitations will be mailed out this month. The support of India's Divan at our activities is most appreciated. We will have our annual Christmas party on Wednesday, December 11th, once again at the home of Jennifer and Mike Driskill, featuring a pot luck dinner and "Dirty Santa" gift exchange. We will also participate in the two temple-sponsored December parades. Annual dues statements for regular and associate members will be sent out this month.

Who was the youngest American soldier in World War II? Calvin L. Graham was the youngest U.S. military member during WWII, and is still the youngest recipient of the Purple Heart and Bronze Star. It wasn't unusual for boys to lie about their age to enlist, but Graham was just 12 years old when he forged his mother's signature and headed to Houston to enlist. The 125-pound, 5-foot-2 boy was miraculously cleared for naval service and assigned to the USS South Dakota as an anti-aircraft gunner. On November 14, 1942, the South Dakota was ambushed by Japanese forces at the Battle of Guadalcanal. Graham was severely burned and thrown down three stories of the ship, but still mustered the strength to tend to his severely wounded shipmates. He was honored for his heroism, but when his mother found out about the honor, she informed the Navy of his real age and he was stripped of his medals and thrown into the brig for three months. In 1978, President Jimmy Carter learned of Graham's story and restored his medals, except for his Purple Heart, which wasn't restored until two years after Graham's death.

If you are a veteran and are not a member of a parade unit, please consider joining us as a regular member. We are also happy to welcome associate members who belong to other units for just a \$5.00 contribution. The dues paid by our associate members are used to provide the U.S. flag that flies just outside the parking lot entrance to the Shrine Center.
