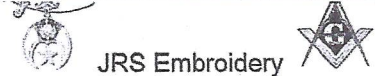

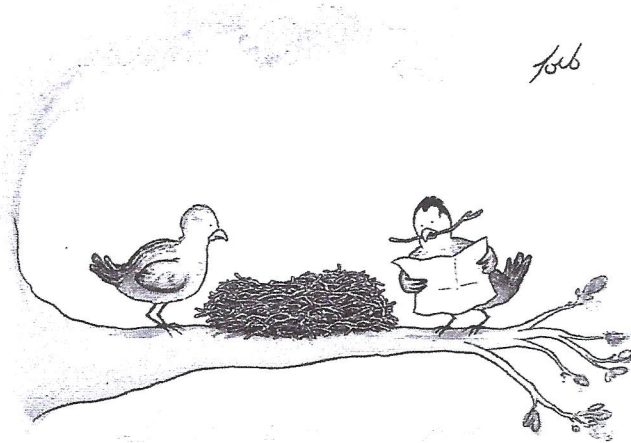



- **January 22, 1969:** Operation Dewey Canyon began in the A Shau/Da Krong Valleys.
- **January 1, 2008:** Logistics was established as a basic branch of the Army.
