- **January 10, 1995**: The Pentagon announced that 2,600 U.S. Marines would be deployed to Somalia for Operation United Shield.
- **January 21, 1918**: The 1st Aeronautical Company arrived at Ponta Delgada, Azores, for anti-submarine duty.
- January 22, 1969: Operation Dewey Canyon began in the A Shau/Da Krong Valleys.
- January 1, 2008: Logistics was established as a basic branch of the Army.
