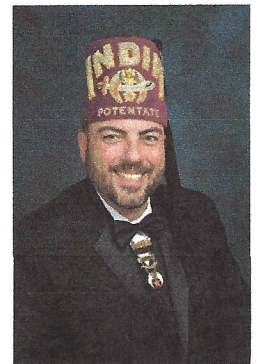

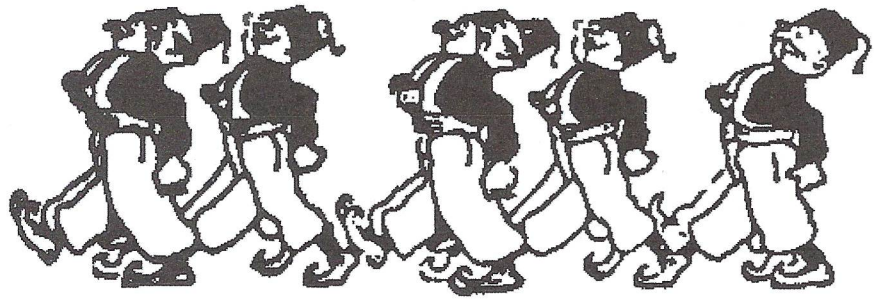



- **December 11, 1941:** Germany and Italy declared war on the United States.
- **December 15, 2011:** The official end of the War in Iraq was declared.
- **December 16, 1944:** The Battle of the Bulge began.
- **December 20, 1989:** The U.S. began the Panama Campaign.
- **December 20, 2019:** The U.S. Space Force was established.
- **December 24, 1914:** An unofficial Christmas truce occurred between German and Allied soldiers during World War I.
- **December 29, 1972:** Operation Linebacker II, a major air campaign during the Vietnam War, concluded after 11 days of bombing.
