Ok, Happy April Fools Day!

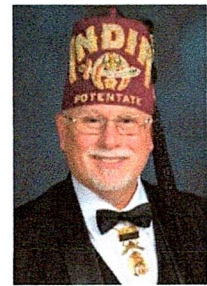

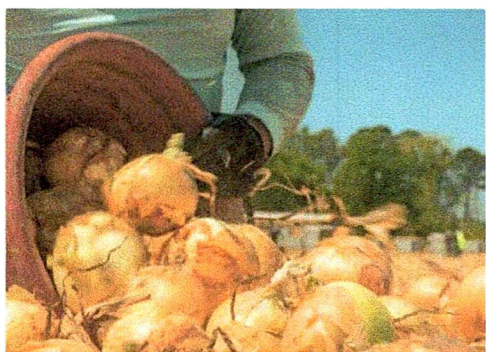
Our International convention is scheduled for May 6-10 in Lexington, Kentucky.

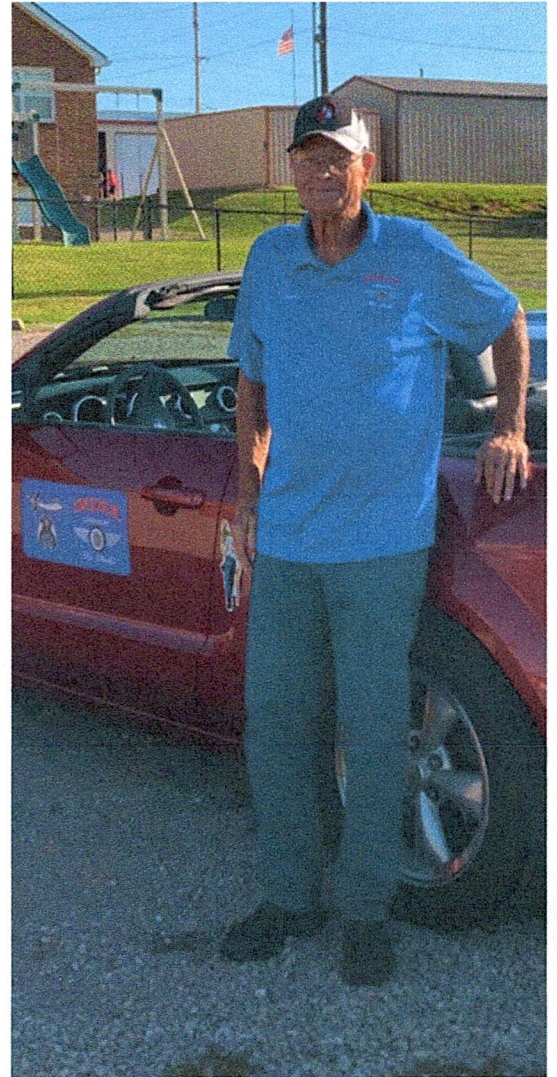
