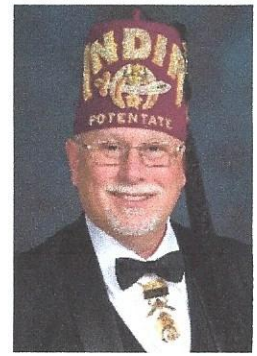

Here's to carrying this momentum forward into the rest of the summer.

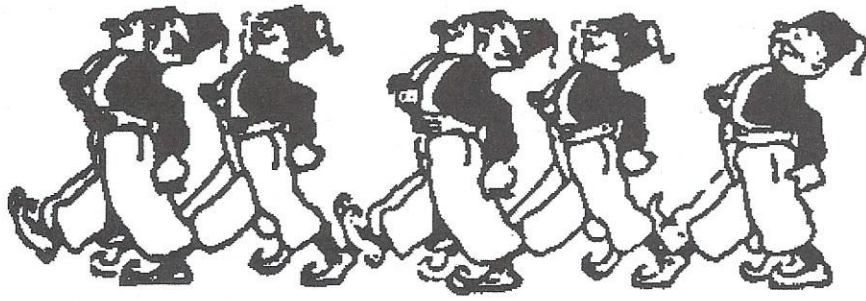

The Siege of Vicksburg ended July 4, 1863. General Ulysses S. Grant's victory gave the Union control of the Mississippi River, permanently splitting the Confederacy in two. The Army established the 10th Cavalry Regiment, better known as the Buffalo Soldiers, in 1866 at Ft. Leavenworth, Kansas. July 28th is National Buffalo Soldiers Day. The Army Chaplain Corps was established by the Continental Congress on July 29, 1775.

A thought on Independence Day – “Humanity has won its battle. Liberty now has a country.” **Bro. Gilbert du Motier, Marquis de Lafayette**. Lafayette was only 19 when he came to America to join the Revolution. The evidence is not concrete, but it is believed that Lafayette was made a Master Mason in France before coming to America, probably in the St. Jean de la Candeur Lodge in Paris.

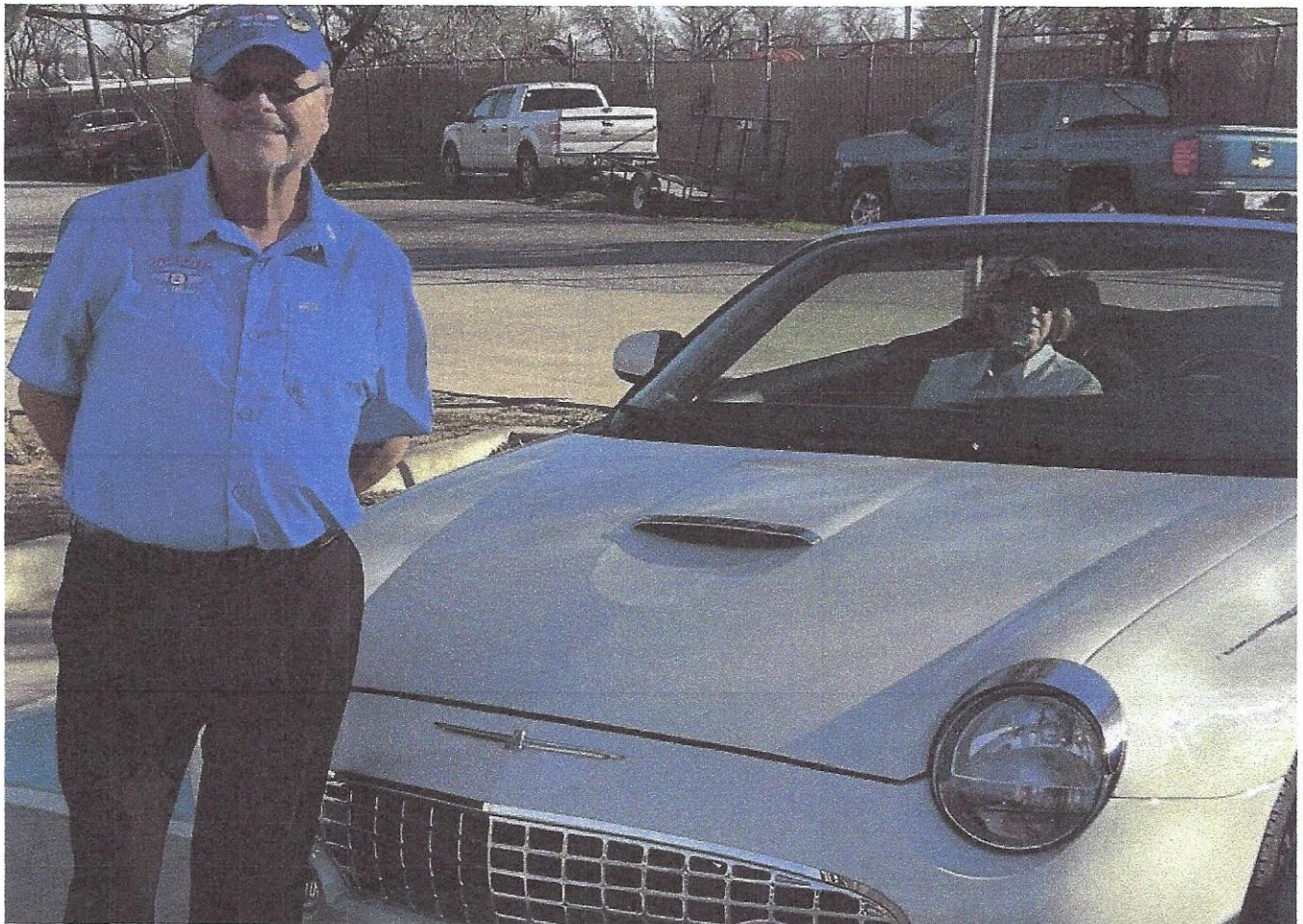

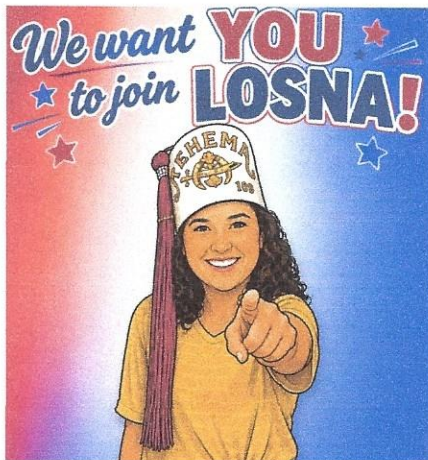
